## Incentives:

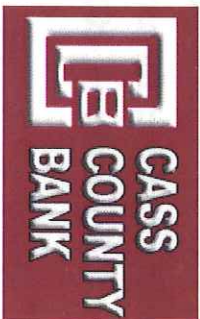

# Mayor's Showcase Neighborhood



The goal of the Mayor's

**Showcase Neighborhood** is to inspire neighbors to improve the quality of life within their own residential neighborhood.



**Criteria for this program include:**

- Must be inside the City of Plattsmouth
- Must be at least one residential block or cul de sac
- Must include all properties on the block or cul de sac
- Improvements may include property cleanups, planning/landscaping, painting, any other maintenance or improvements that beautify and/or improve the quality for the neighborhood.
- Credit will be given for assisting seniors within the selected block.
- Credit will be given for providing evidence of sustaining the improvements beyond the recognition period.

**Timeline:**

- ◆ Announce via mailer to all properties within the City in early June 2011
- ◆ By July 15, neighborhood submits notice of intent to participate to the City Clerk, City Hall, 136 N 5th, Plattsmouth.
- ◆ Submit a record of the neighborhood improvement project for judging by 5:00 p.m., September 6, 2011.
- ◆ Recognition and reward during September 19, 2011, City Council Meeting.

**Narrative and photographs of improvements should include:**

- Description of the residential neighborhood (e.g., street addresses of properties included)
- Narrative description of the project - who did what?
- Photographs showing before and after
- Describe how the neighborhood will sustain its improvements beyond the initial improvement and recognition period.
- If assistance was provided to seniors, describe the assistance, who and what was provided.
- Tell how the cash incentive will be shared among participants.
