ORDINANCE NO. 2038

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR CITY SERVICES; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Plattsmouth has determined that the fee structure for services and products provided by the City shall be revised as follows (all rates subject to 7% sales tax):
