Motion by Kerns, seconded by Bowman to adopt Resolution No. 11-001:

RESOLUTION NO. 11-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA TO AUTHORIZE, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS HEREOF, A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR THE PLATTSMOUTH COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, CASS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1, TO OPERATE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION FACILITIES IN A GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT (GC) ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 15508 2ND AVENUE, PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, application was made for a special use permit;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the application; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the application was held October 4, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that the application of Plattsmouth Community School District, Cass County School District No. 1, for a special use permit to operate primary and secondary education facilities in a GC (General Commercial) District on property located at 15508 2ND Avenue, legally described as Plattsmouth Outlots, Pt Db 147, P465, Northwest ½ 24-12-13 (.63 Acres), is approved subject to the following conditions which shall be satisfied at the School District's expense:

- 1. Stop signs shall be placed on the minor approach at all drives from the proposed site onto 2^{nd} Avenue where traffic control signs are currently not in place.
- 2. The existing sidewalk at the entrance of the school be extended to the west of 2^{nd} Avenue.
- 3. A crosswalk shall be striped to accommodate pedestrian crossing of 2nd Avenue from Plattsmouth High School to the Vocational Education Classrooms. Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Device (MUTCD) approved school crossing

signs (S1-1 and W16-7P shall be placed at the crosswalk location and a school advance crossing assembly (S1-1 and W16-9P) approximately 200 feet in advance of the crossing on both the Northbound and Southbound approach.

Council Member Bowman introduced a Resolution numbered and titled: RESOLUTION NO. 11-002: A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA TO PROHIBIT OVERNIGHT PARKING IN PUBLICLY OWNED PARKING LOTS IN THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, CASS COUNTY, NEBRASKA WHICH ARE LOCATED IN ZONING DISTRICTS OTHER THAN CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

After introduction of Resolution No. 11-002, motion by Bowman to amend Resolution No. 11-002 to specify no parking between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. and adopt Resolution No. 11-002 as amended. Mayor Lambert deemed the motion dead for lack of a second.

Mayor Lambert expressed his concerns regarding parking in the Senior Center parking lot during the winter months and the problems it creates when plowing/removing snow. Kerns questioned the issue at the old pool parking lot (4th Avenue) directly east of the Memorial Ball Field. After further discussion, Motion by Kerns, seconded by Porter to adopt Resolution No. 11-002 as amended by the City Attorney (would effect the Senior/Community Center only and from 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.).

ITEM 9 G

Mike Wilson, Chief of the Plattsmouth Volunteer Fire Department gave his annual report to the Mayor and Council. The Department has 53 members in good standing-7 did not meet the annual requirements for a member in good standing status. 212 calls were answered for 2010-73 call increase from 2009 (106 City calls/106 Rural calls). 3,129 man hours were put in from alarm time to return to station. 1,878 alarms were answered in the last decade.

The Jaws of Life is out of service and they are researching their options. The Thermal Imager and the Fill Station have been ordered and will be funded out of Donation monies. The Airpacks were tested and all passed but 13 masks failed. In 2011 the Department has a 2 month trial for a new computer program "I am Responding"- A member contacts the program via cell phone to alert the system they are responding or are out of area. The 2011 Officers are: Mike Wilson-Chief; Bill Dudek-1st Assistant Chief; Brian Wuelling-2nd Assistant Chief; Stand pasko-President; Bruce Johnson-Vice President; Debbie Knopik-Secretary; and Jim Paczkowski-Treasurer. The 2011 Training and Safety Officers are: Craig Shrimpton-Captain; Scott Reissig-Fire Lieutenant; Leroy Lewis-Fire Lieutenant; Shawn Dillon-Fire Lieutenant; Eric Grimshaw-Safety Officer; and Lee Bogle-Safety Officer.
