NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Agency that the Redevelopment Contract by and between Redeveloper and the Agency, in the form presented is hereby acknowledged and approved. The Agency Chairperson and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute said Redevelopment Contract in substantially the form presented but with such changes as they shall deem appropriate or necessary. The execution and delivery by the Chairperson of the Redevelopment Contract, or any such documents, instruments, agreements or certifications relating to such matters contained in the Redevelopment Contract, shall conclusively establish their authority with respect thereto and the authorization and approval thereof.
