Steve Perry PE, Olmsted & Perry Consulting Engineers Inc. reviewed the proposed 2023 One and Six Year Highway and Street Improvement Program for the City of Plattsmouth. There are 10 One year projects and 10 Six year projects. When referencing the map the blue lines are the one year projects and the green lines are the six year projects. Following discussion, Motion by Kerns seconded by Brookhouser to approve the City of Plattsmouth 2023 One-and Six Year Highway and Street Improvement Program. Motion by Forrest seconded by Brookhouser to Accept the Bid and Award Contract to Kerns Excavating Co. for Snow Removal/Hauling for the Public Works Department starting November 1, 2022 through May 1, 2023 in the City of Plattsmouth "AS NEEDED" and authorize the Mayor to execute the contract. Emily Bausch, City Administrator gave background on the proposed Physician Medical Director, Eric Ernest, M.D. Dr. Ernest is currently the State Medical Director; Cass EMS Medical Director; and Bellevue Medical Director. He is willing to take on the Plattsmouth EMS Department as the Medical Director and there is no increase in fees when compared to the current contract. Motion by Forrest seconded by Derby to approve an agreement by and between the City of Plattsmouth and UNMC Physicians, a Nebraska non-profit corporation for a Physician Medical Director responsible for the overall medical control of the Plattsmouth Emergency Medical Services. Emily Bausch, City Administrator gave background on the Deed Restriction on property owned by the City of Plattsmouth described as PLATTSMOUTH - FOURMILE INDUSTRIAL PARK LOT 12 and OUTLOT A for 0.20-acre of wetlands for the Mitigation Plan for the Plattsmouth Wastewater Treatment Plant Access Road. This is the execution of the Mitigation Plan. Motion by Brookhouser seconded by Forrest to approve a Deed Restriction on property owned by the City of Plattsmouth described as PLATTSMOUTH - FOURMILE INDUSTRIAL PARK LOT 12 and OUTLOT A for 0.20-acre of wetlands for the Mitigation Plan for the Plattsmouth Wastewater Treatment Plant Access Road. ITEM 9 F

Emily Bausch, City Administrator and Stephen Q. Preston, City Attorney explained the PACE (Property Assessed Clean Energy) program and how it could work for projects in Plattsmouth. It may be an economic development tool offered to qualified groups/individuals and is intended to encourage energy efficiency. This may be a program offered to commercial and residential projects/new construction or rehabilitation of existing buildings. The expense to the City would be the time spent administering the program. The benefits to the property owner/developer were discussed. Council inquired as to other communities who have implemented the PACE program. Council directed city staff to move forward with research and legislation to implement a PACE Program.
